28:22	Ed and Biko laugh about Mr. Bernie, neighborhood character.
30:20	Ed remembers his kindergarten teacher whom he had a crush on. Ed remembers playing basketball in various Pittsburgh neighborhoods. There were not neighborhood boundaries.
32:00	Biko talks about the realness and craziness of gang violence. This is reflected in his attitude.
33:40	Biko remembers kid involved in drugs who accidentally killed 2 people in a car.
35:15	Biko wants to be a buffer for violence through art and conversation with the young kids.
37:01	Biko and Ed recall nicknames from their childhood.
39:35	Ed remembers a guy named Mr. Gut
40:11	Ed remembers Thelma Jackson, who caught Ed stuffing his bad papers under rocks.
